CARE SHEET

As with all products containing an adhesive system a drying time is necessary in the achievement of a proper bond to the window. During this process some changes may be observed. So that you will understand these changes we would like to note some of them for you. They are normal and should be expected to occur.

- Drying time will be approximately 30 days. Please do not wash your windows during this period.
- Any haziness you may see is water under the film. You will see less and less of this as the days pass.
- You may notice squeegee marks or soap streaks, especially around the edges where we apply a "pressure seal". These will wash off easily. Again, please wait at least 30 days.
- All water bubbles will dry out, but a few small particles or points may be apparent when dry. These points generally seen from the outside are very tiny and are inherent in the use of a water-activated pressure sensitive adhesive system. You will normally see these particles only if you get quite close to the glass.
- The border on the edge is a requirement and must be there in order to validate the warranty. The purpose of the border is to allow for the expansion and contraction of the glass and, also, to allow the window to properly dry.
- Cleaning should be done using any non-abrasive window cleaning solution. A spray bottle with water and a few drops of liquid soap works fine. Use a soft cloth and/or squeegee for best results. Above all, DO NOT USE paper towels. They are extremely abrasive. Other items which can damage film include bristle brushes, newspaper, scotch tape and suction cups.
- Sometimes a customer feels that he or she sees a defect in the film when it is, in fact, a blemish in the glass. It is quite natural that one should look closely at a new purchase, but at times, we observe things that were always there but never noticed. Also, due to an imperfect environment, there may be some dust or dirt particles trapped between the film and glass. During the first few weeks these particles are surrounded by water. Once the water dries out these small dots will not be noticeable.

We hope you will enjoy your installation. With proper care, we know you will receive many years of benefit from its presence on your windows.
